- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-39 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to property and casualty insurance policies for debris removal.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-39 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Property and casualty policies - Required contract term Debris removal.

Each property and casualty must include a term providing if an insured property is destroyed by an event covered by a policy issued under section 26.1-39-10, becomessubstandard under subsection 23 of section 40-05-01, and a city incurs costs for demolition. repair, or removal of the substandard structure or building, the insurer shall directly reimbursethe city from the proceeds due to be tendered to the insured for the cost of demolition, repair, or removal on the insured property

- An insurer covering a building or property, upon submission of a valid invoice to the insurer by a city or other political subdivision, shall directly reimburse the city or political subdivision for any cost incurred for debris removal, clean-up, foundation removal, or excavation due to be tendered to the insured on the insured property.
- In the absence of insurance coverage for debris removal, clean-up, foundation removal, and excavation, the city or political subdivision may seek reimbursement directly from the property owner.
