## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2285**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-08-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to crashes involving damage to property; and to provide a penalty.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-08-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 39-08-05. Crashes involving damage to vehicle property Penalty.
- The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash resulting only in property damage to the
- 8 driver's vehicle or any other, another vehicle, or any other fixed object on public or private
- 9 property, shall immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash or as close to the scene of
- 10 the crash as possible but shall return to and remain at the scene of the crash until the driver has
- 11 fulfilled the requirements of sections 39-08-06, 39-08-08, and 39-08-09. Every such stop
- must be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary. Any person failing to stop or
- 13 comply with the requirements in this section is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
