Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in interpreting or applying a statute, regulation, or rule, a judge may not defer to a governmental entity's interpretation of the statute, regulation, or rule. After applying all customary rules of interpretation, the court shall resolve any remaining ambiguity against increased agency authority.
