

**SECOND ENGROSSMENT  
with Conference Committee Amendments  
REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2063**

Introduced by

(At the request of the Department of Transportation)

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 24-02-45.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to reimbursable federal electric vehicle infrastructure grants; and to provide for a  
3 legislative management report.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 24-02-45.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted  
6 as follows:

7 **24-02-45.4. Reimbursable federal electric vehicle infrastructure grants - Agreements**  
8 **with public or private entities for the administration of federal aid programs - Report.**

9 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law but subject to legislative appropriation, the  
10 director may enter agreements and may accept any federal or nonstate funds for the  
11 administration of reimbursable electric vehicle charging grant programs.

12 a. The director may enter an agreement with any person for the administration,  
13 approval, and inspection of a project to be constructed by a public or private  
14 entity, or a political subdivision.

15 b. The cost-share for any project may consist only of federal, public, political  
16 subdivision, or private funding.

17 c. A political subdivision may not have an ownership interest in an electric vehicle  
18 charging station.

19 d. Any federal formula funding for reimbursement grants must be at least ten  
20 percent of the cost-share for a project, but may not exceed eighty percent.

21 e. The director may establish criteria for the grants and determine a reasonable  
22 grant reimbursement cost-share or limit for the project in accordance with federal  
23 aid provisions.

- 1        2. In accordance with the federal formula program, the director shall establish criteria for
- 2            the consideration of operation and maintenance costs of the electric charging stations
- 3            in the grant award.
- 4        3. Before July 1, 2024, the department of transportation shall present a report to the
- 5            legislative management regarding an update on the deployment and administration of
- 6            electric vehicle charging stations.
