SB 2140 defines insulin drug and medical supplies for insulin dosing and administration. Provides a \$25 cost share limit, restricts the use of a formulary to determine coverage, and clarifies the limitations of cost-sharing.

Combining the estimated cost of capping the out-of-pocket amount at \$25 per month and the rebate reduction estimate from eliminating a formulary for insulin has the effect of increasing the premium in the uniform group insurance program 1.5%-1.6% in the 2023-2025 biennium. A fiscal note was submitted using a 1.55% increase.
