That the House recede from its amendments as printed on pages	of the Sena	ate

be amended as follows:		

Page 1, line 2, after "services" insert "; to provide an appropriation to the legislative council" Page 4, after line 13, insert:

## "SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

- There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the legislative council for consulting services for a study of the department of health and human services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
- 2. During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall conduct a study of the department of health and human services. As part of the study, the legislative management shall review:
  - a. The structure of the department, including how the structure affects the overall delivery of services;
  - Programs administered by the department, including the efficiency, effectiveness, and outcomes of the programs;
  - Collaboration among programs within the department;
  - d. The integration of the programs of the former state department of health;
  - e. The coordination of services provided by the department with services provided by private providers;
  - Sources of federal funding including use of the funding and compliance with federal requirements;
  - g. Department administrative processes and costs; and
  - h. The effectiveness of client outreach efforts to inform citizens of available services.
- 3. The Legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation needed to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly."
