## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

This amendment allows unexpended 2021-23 biennium appropriations for the substance use disorder voucher system to be used during the 2023-25 biennium for human service centers to become certified community behavioral health clinics. This will reduce anticipated general fund turnback by \$10 million.
