Section 7 would increase legislators' interim meeting pay by 2 percent in the 1st year and 3 percent in the 2nd year of the 2023-25 biennium.

Section 5 provides the unspent funds appropriated for the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council for the 2021-23 biennium be continued and unexpended appropriations enacted prior to the 2021-23 biennium may be canceled as directed by the Chairman of the Legislative Management or the Director of the Legislative Council.
