# Three Groups in ND Focused on Children/Youth:

## **Juvenile Justice Advisory Group**

- Established in 1988 pursuant to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974
- Created to advise the Governor and legislature on juvenile justice issues, including compliance with the Act

### Role:

- Develop a comprehensive state juvenile justice plan
- Review and award grants pursuant to the plan, and monitor progress of programs funded
- Monitor compliance with the JJDPA
- Provide leadership, training and technical assistance on best practice
- Advocate for juvenile justice reform
- Interface between state and fed

## Children's Cabinet

- Established in 2019 w/SB 2313
- Created to assess, guide, and coordinate the care for children across the state's branches of government and the tribal nations

#### Role:

- Coordinate leadership across agencies to meet needs of children
- Develop strategies to address gaps regarding early care and education, medical, behavioral health, community, child welfare, and juvenile justice
- Develop strategies to promote the full continuum of care
- Provide a comprehensive vision for how/where children are best served

## Commission on Juvenile Justice

- Established in 2019 w/SB 2313 and reports to the Children's Cabinet (Expires 7/31/25)
- Created to gather information, receive reports, and make recommendations regarding effective services for children

### Role:

- Review Chapter 27-20
- Gather information concerning issues of child welfare, including education, abuse and neglect
- Receive reports and testimony in furtherance of the duties
- Advise on effective interventions, resources, and services for children
