Testimony of Todd N. Ewell, Deputy Director, NDCLCI

Good Morning. Chairman Klemin, members of the Committee, my name is Todd

Ewell and I am the Deputy Director of the North Dakota Commission on Legal Counsel for

Indigents (hereinafter "the Commission"). We are the state agency responsible for the

delivery of constitutionally mandated public defense services.

I rise today to in support of HB 1289. The Commission believes permitting drug court

judges to waive fines, fees, and costs for successful drug court participants creates an

incentive to successful completion. In addition, if the judge were to determine a participant

is indigent, passage of this bill would avoid unnecessary court administrative time by

attempting to collect on an account where collection is unlikely. On behalf of the

Commission, I request a Do Pass recommendation for HB 1289.
