May 10, 2022 our Board of Directors voted to support a local proposal to approve a Hate Crime Ordinance. The Bismarck City Commission at that time indicated that this was something that should be done at the state level. Please accept this testimony as our continued support for this concept.

The Downtowners Association represents nearly 9,000 employees in a variety of businesses citywide, and for the last decade a barrier to business growth has been the lack of available workers. An ordinance or law such as this brings us inline with competing communities' policies and assists Bismarck in talent recruitment and retention efforts.
