3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE
- 5 **IMPACTS.** During the 2023-24 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the
- 6 rapid emergence of artificial intelligence and the potential impacts on the state's institutions,
- agencies, businesses, citizens, and youth. The study must include a review of the effect of
- artificial intelligence on the provision of health care, effects on student learning, potential
- 9 opportunities or threats to the integrity of state services, the potential impact of deep fakes on
- 10 electoral processes including mitigating action to be taken leading up to the 2024 state
- elections, opportunities for state investment or policy changes to promote artificial intelligence
- businesses, and cybersecurity implications across all state institutions. The legislative
- management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
- 14 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
