

SB 2017 2023-25 Appropriation Request North Dakota Game and Fish Department Potential Land Acquisitions

As of January 3, 2023

The Department has been contacted by individuals with the following tracts. They are interested in selling these tracts to the Department to be maintained as Wildlife Management Areas (WMA). Some opportunities may arise throughout the biennium that could get higher priority. The following list is in no particular order.

- 1) Adams County 480 acres Land is currently in CRP.
- 2) Burleigh County 152 acres Property is entirely wetlands.
- 3) Dunn County 950 acres Mostly Pastureland near Killdeer WMA.
- 4) Hettinger County 80 acres Land is currently in CRP.
- 5) Lamoure County 160 acres Primarily wetlands.
- 6) McLean County 30 acres Addition to the Coal Lake WMA for improved access.
- McLean County 160 acres Mostly pastureland with native woodlands.
- 8) Pembina County 360 Dunklee WMA addition. Enrolled in NRCS Emergency Watershed Protection, so no agricultural practices are allowed.
- Walsh County 140 acre Located along Red River and enrolled in NRCS Wetland Reserve Program, so no agricultural practices are allowed.
- 10) Williams County 348 acres Trenton WMA Addition (floodplain and access to WMA).
