Line item transfer authority

Contingent authority and full-time equalivalent positions - Recovering America's Wildlife Act

Section 4 would authorize the Office of Management and Budget to transfer up to \$2 million of appropriation authority between the operating expenses, capital assets, and grants - game and fish line items during the 2023-25 biennium. The department must report Section 3 would include in the grants, gifts, and donations line item \$100,000 received by the Game and Fish Department for surface damage, easements, or reclamation of department-owned or department-managed properties from oil or mining activities.
