Section 3 provides authority for the Secretary of State to transfer funding between line items.

Section 4 provides the statutory changes increasing the Secretary of State's salary. The Secretary of State's annual salary would increase from the current level of \$114,486 to \$130,000, effective July 1, 2023, and to \$135,200, effective July 1, 2024, to reflect the annual 4 percent salary increases, starting from a base of \$125,000.
