- 4 Education Committee.
- 5 I come to you today representing one of the most rapidly growing
- school districts in the state. In April of 2021, 78% of Mandan
- 5 School District votes approved an \$84,000,000 bond issue to
- build a new elementary school and a new high school. Mandan
- 9 Public School was planning to spend roughly \$10M in federal
- 10 ESSER dollars to cover the \$94M estimated cost. However, when
- the project was bid in the summer of 2022, inflation had driven
- the project costs up to \$114,000,000. This is over a 20% increase
- over pre-bid estimates provided to us.
- 14 Mandan Public Schools is working hard to close the \$20M gap
- created by inflation without having to go back to our taxpayers.
- To address this gap we have received \$8.3M in the CTE grant,
- which we thank both the Senate and House for recently passing.
- We also believe we will be able to secure \$3M from business

- partners and another \$4M when we sell surrounding property.
- 2 Mandan Public Schools has some existing authority in our
- building fund, but this legislation would help us ensure we don't
- 4 need to raise taxes beyond the \$99 per \$100,000 in taxable value
- that we promised our taxpayers before inflation took a dramatic
- 6 hike.
- As shared by Dr. Vollmer, a lower rate is tax relief for the citizens
- 8 of these rapidly growing communities that are doing their best to
- 9 ensure adequate educational spaces for the ever increasing
- number of students in our districts.
