4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 14-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Parental rights - Attendance at activities.

- 1. AUnless otherwise provided in North Dakota Century Code or by court order, a school
- 9 <u>district may not prohibit a student's parent or guardian from attending a school-sponsored</u>
- 10 student activity in which the student is participating, including an extracurricular activity or
- 11 cocurricular activity. This section does not permit an individual to attend a school-sponsored
- 12 <u>student activity without paying an admission fee if so required.</u>
- 2. A private entity may not prohibit a minor child's parent or guardian from attending an
 activity in which the minor child is participating, including a competition, match,
- 15 contest, or performance.
