## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 38-22-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 38-22-08. Permit requirements.
- 9 Before issuing a permit, the commission shall find:
- 1. That the storage operator has complied with all requirements set by the commission.
- 11 2. That the storage facility is suitable and feasible for carbon dioxide injection and storage.
- 13 3. That the carbon dioxide to be stored is of a quality that allows it to be safely and efficiently stored in the storage reservoir.
- 15 | 4. That the storage operator has made a good-faith effort to get<u>obtained</u> the consent of all persons who own the storage reservoir's pore space.
  - 5. That the storage operator has obtained the consent of persons who own at least sixtyeighty-five percent of the storage reservoir's pore space. If a county elects to require written consent from more than eighty-five percent of the persons that own the storage reservoir's pore space, the storage operator has received written consent from the specified percentage of the owners required by the county.
  - 6. Whether the storage facility contains commercially valuable minerals and, if it does, a permit may be issued only if the commission is satisfied that the interests of the mineral owners or mineral lessees will not be adversely affected or have been
