

FIRST ENGROSSMENT**ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2023**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the North Dakota
2 racing commission.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds, to the
7 North Dakota racing commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the North Dakota
8 racing commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as
9 follows:

18 **SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

19 **SEVENTIETH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
20 items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act which are not included in the entity's
21 base budget for the 2027-29 biennium and which the entity shall report to the appropriations
22 committees of the seventieth legislative assembly regarding the use of this funding:

SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The racing commission may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item in section 1 of the Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to the racing commission line item in accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill No. 1015, as approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
