- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 environmental quality.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and federal funds, to the department of environmental quality for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department of environmental quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows:

- 21 The other funds line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 from the
- 22 environment and rangeland protection fund. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the
- North Dakota stockmen's association environmental services program.

- 1 SECTION 3. OTHER FUNDS PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND.
- 2 The other funds line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$723,595 from the
- 3 petroleum tank release compensation fund for expenses related to the petroleum tank release
- 4 program.
