ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2032

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 26.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the comprehensive health association of North Dakota; to repeal chapters 26.1-08
- 3 and 26.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the comprehensive health
- 4 association of North Dakota; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 26.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

- 10 <u>1.</u> "Association" means the comprehensive health association of North Dakota.
- 11 2. "Board" means the comprehensive health association of North Dakota board of directors.
- 3. "Creditable coverage" means, with respect to an individual, coverage under chapter
 26.1-08.
- 15 <u>4. "Guaranteed issue" means an issuer may not:</u>
- 16 <u>a.</u> Deny or condition the issuance or effectiveness of a Medicare supplement policy
 17 <u>that is offered and is available for issuance to new enrollees by the issuer;</u>
 - b. Discriminate in the pricing of such a Medicare supplement policy because of health status, claims experience, receipt of health care, or medical condition; or
- 20 <u>c. Impose an exclusion of benefits based on a preexisting condition under such a</u>
 21 <u>Medicare supplement policy.</u>

1	<u>5.</u>	"Lead carrier" means the insurance company selected by the board to administer the
2		association benefit plans.
3	<u>26.</u> 1	I-08.1-02. Cessation of operations.
4	<u>1.</u>	The association shall cease enrollment under the plan effective May 1, 2025.
5	<u>2.</u>	After taking all reasonable steps, including those specified in this section, to timely and
6		efficiently assist in the transition of individuals receiving benefits under chapter
7		26.1-08, and paying health insurance claims for plan coverage and meeting all other
8		obligations of the board under this section, the association shall cease operating the
9		pool.
10	<u>3.</u>	The association may take any action it deems necessary to:
11		a. Cease enrollment for plan coverage effective May 1, 2025.
12		b. Terminate all existing benefit plans effective December 31, 2025.
13		c. Provide at least a ninety-day notice to current policyholders of the termination.
14	<u>4.</u>	This section does not require the board to revise plan benefits to comply with this
15		chapter.
16	<u>26.1</u>	I-08.1-03. Board of directors.
17	<u>1.</u>	Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, to facilitate an efficient cessation
18		of operations, the board:
19		a. May continue to use the lead carrier to fulfill administrative tasks and operations.
20		b. Shall continue to follow the requirements of participating members under section
21		<u>26.1-08-09.</u>
22		c. May implement a process to assess members based on actual program costs
23		rather than projected program costs.
24	<u>2.</u>	If the board has excess funds after cessation of operations of the association, the
25		funds must be returned by the lead carrier to the insurer assessed under section
26		<u>26.1-08-09.</u>
27	<u>26.1</u>	I-08.1-04. Enrollment of individuals losing creditable coverage.
28	<u>An i</u>	ndividual losing creditable coverage must be provided enrollment into a comparable:
29	<u>1.</u>	Health benefit plan; or
30	<u>2.</u>	Plan under a Medicare supplement policy that has a benefit package classified as

plan A, B, C, F (including F with a high deductible), G, K, or L under guaranteed issue.

- 2 A cause of action against the association or the board must be commenced within the
- 3 earlier of one year after the cause of action occurs or December 31, 2027.
- 4 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Chapters 26.1-08 and 26.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 5 are repealed.
- 6 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Section 2 of this Act becomes effective December 31,
- 7 2027.
- 8 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
