- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of an office of entrepreneurship; and to provide for a
- 3 legislative management report.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 Office of entrepreneurship Duties Report.
- 8 <u>1. As used in this section:</u>

- 9 <u>a. "Business" means a corporation, partnership, company, cooperative, sole</u>
 10 <u>proprietorship, or other legal entity organized or operating for pecuniary or</u>
 11 nonpecuniary gain.
- b. "Entrepreneur" means an individual who initiates and assumes the financial risk
 of a business.
 - <u>c.</u> "State agency" means an agency, board, commission, bureau, office,
 <u>department, institution, and any other state governmental entity. The term</u>
 <u>excludes the legislative and judicial branches of state government.</u>
- - a. Work to strengthen policies and programs supporting the growth of entrepreneurship in the state, including across demographic segments and geographic areas.

1		<u>b.</u>	Work with stakeholders and organizations supporting entrepreneurship to:	
2			(1) Enhance the learning and skills of entrepreneurs;	
3			(2) Provide technical support to entrepreneurs; and	
4			(3) Expand access to resources for entrepreneurs.	
5		<u>C.</u>	Serve as a point of contact to assist businesses that have been in operation less	
6			than five years, in their interactions with state agencies and, when appropriate,	
7			refer the businesses to other state or local agencies that provide assistance to	
8			<u>businesses.</u>	
9	<u>3.</u>	A state agency shall cooperate with and assist the office of entrepreneurship in the		
10		per	ormance of its duties and functions.	
11	<u>4.</u>	Before August of each year, the office of entrepreneurship shall provide a report to the		
12		legislative management which includes:		
13		<u>a.</u>	A summary of work accomplished in support of growing entrepreneurship in the	
14			state;	
15		<u>b.</u>	A summary of events held to drive collaboration with stakeholders and	
16			organizations supporting entrepreneurship;	
17		<u>C.</u>	The number of participating businesses that have been in operation less than five	
18			<u>years;</u>	
19		<u>d.</u>	Recommendations for improving entrepreneurship in the state, including	
20			identifying regional challenges to entrepreneurship; and	
21		<u>e.</u>	Any additional information deemed necessary to provide an accurate depiction of	
22			the condition of entrepreneurship in the state.

24		acc	ordance with this section are an exempt record under section 44-04-17.1.
