- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to review by the superintendent of public instruction of school district
- 3 compliance with education-related state law and rule; and to amend and reenact sections
- 4 15.1-02-04 and 15.1-14-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to school district
- 5 compliance with education-related law and rule.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 15.1-02-04. Superintendent of public instruction Duties Report. (Effective through
- 10 December 31, 2024)
- 11 The superintendent of public instruction:
- 12 1. Shall supervise the provision of elementary and secondary education to the students
- of this state.
- 2. Shall supervise the establishment and maintenance of schools and provide advice and
- 15 counsel regarding the welfare of the schools.
- 16 3. Shall supervise the development of course content standards.
- 17 4. Shall supervise the assessment of students.
- 18 5. Shall serve as an ex officio member of the board of university and school lands.
- 19 6. Shall keep a complete record of all official acts and appeals.
- 20 7. As appropriate, shall determine the outcome of appeals regarding education matters.
- 21 8. Shall direct school district annexation, reorganization, and dissolution and employ and
- 22 compensate personnel necessary to enable the state board of public school education
- 23 to carry out its powers and duties regarding school district annexation, reorganization,
- 24 and dissolution.

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- 1 Shall facilitate a process to review and update annually the statewide prekindergarten 2 through grade twelve education strategic vision. The process must include input and 3 participation from a steering committee that includes representatives of all state-level-4 entities receiving state education funding and education stakeholder groups. Each 5 steering committee member entity receiving state education funds shall provide 6 components of the entity's strategic plan which are aligned to the statewide strategic-7 vision. The steering committee shall prepare a collaborative report of the strategic 8 plans of each committee member entity receiving state education funds. The 9 superintendent shall provide the collaborative report and any updates to the strategic 10 vision to the legislative management during each interim and to a joint meeting of the 11 education standing committees during each regular legislative session.
 - 10. Shall facilitate the development and implementation of a North Dakota learning continuum in collaboration with the department of career and technical education, upon the recommendation of the kindergarten through grade twelve education coordination council.
- 11. Shall appoint a task force in collaboration with the kindergarten through grade twelve education coordination council. The task force shall review all statutes in this code relating to literacy, dyslexia, and related teacher training and report the findings and recommendations of the task force, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
 - Superintendent of public instruction Duties <u>- Report</u>. (Effective after December 31, 2024) The superintendent of public instruction:
 - 1. Shall supervise the provision of elementary and secondary education to the students of this state.
 - 2. Shall supervise the establishment and maintenance of schools and provide advice and counsel regarding the welfare of the schools.
- 3. Shall supervise the development of course content standards.
- 4. Shall supervise the assessment of students.

 - 11. Shall provide guidance to a school district to promote compliance with educationrelated state and federal law and the rules and regulations of any applicable state or
 federal agency and shall publish the guidance on the department of public instruction's
 website.
- 24 12. Shall review a school district to verify compliance with state law or rule or both and
 25 issue guidance or withhold funding if a condition under subsection 1 of section 2 of this
 26 Act occurs.
 - **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Review for compliance - Procedure - Complaints.

1. The superintendent of public instruction shall conduct a review of a school district to verify compliance with education-related state law or rule or both upon:
