- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of correctional facilities.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.
- 4 During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall study jails and regional
- 5 correctional centers, including their current and projected infrastructure needs, the costs and
- 6 benefits of regional correctional facilities, the impacts of deferred admission, and the
- 7 prioritization of inmates sentenced to the department of corrections and rehabilitation. The study
- 8 must include input from representatives of counties with a population of seven thousand five
- 9 hundred or more, representatives of counties with a population of fewer than seven thousand
- 10 five hundred, local law enforcement officials, representatives of the department of corrections
- and rehabilitation, representatives of the office of management and budget, and the attorney
- 12 general. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
- with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative
- 14 assembly.
