- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-04-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a limitation on the amount of water not applied to beneficial use.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 61-04-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 61-04-03.1. Limitation on amount of water.
  - An applicant may not apply for a permit or permits for irrigation which, if approved, would enable a person, at any one time, to hold a conditional water permit or permits for more than seven hundred twenty acre-feet [888106.75 cubic meters] of water <u>from a single surface or</u>
- 10 ground water source that has not been applied to beneficial use. Applications submitted in
- 11 violation of this section may not be assigned a priority date and must be returned to the
- 12 applicant by the department of water resources. This section may not apply to water permit
- 13 applications from the Missouri River or to applications submitted by irrigation districts organized
- 14 pursuant to this title. For the purposes of this section, "person", when applied to an individual,
- means the individual and the individual's spouse and dependents within the meaning of the
- 16 Internal Revenue Code [26 U.S.C. 152].
