- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-12 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to postpartum doula certification
- 3 and medical assistance benefits for postpartum doula services.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Postpartum doula certification.

 a. "Certified doula" means an individual who has received a certification to perform
 doula services from the doulas of North America or an organization designated
 by the department.
- b. "Department" means the department of health and human services.
- <u>"Doula services" means education and support services for a parent and child,</u>
 <u>including continuous emotional and physical support during the postpartum</u>
 period, including up to six months after the birth of the child.
- 16 <u>2. The department may:</u>
- 17 <u>a. Designate additional doula certification organizations;</u>
- b. Remove the designation of a doula certification organization; and
- 19 <u>c.</u> Adopt rules to implement and administer this section.
- 20 <u>3. The department shall establish criteria for the designation of doula certification</u>
- 21 <u>organizations and maintain a list of designated organizations on the department's</u>
- 22 <u>website for purposes of facilitating the availability of certified doulas to provide doula</u>
- services under section 2 of this Act.

- 1 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 2 and enacted as follows:
- 3 <u>Medical assistance benefits Postpartum doula services.</u>
- 4 <u>1. Medical assistance coverage, including Medicaid expansion coverage, must include</u>
- 5 <u>coverage of postpartum doula services, as defined in section 1 of this Act.</u>
- 6 <u>2.</u> The department shall provide notice to an enrollee regarding the coverage required by
- 7 <u>this section.</u>
