- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 19-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to requirements for selling aerosol dusters containing difluoroethane; to
- 3 amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 19-03.1-22.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 4 relating to the classification of difluoroethane as a volatile chemical; and to provide a penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 19-03.1-22.1 of the North Dakota
- 7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 2. This section does not apply to inhalations specifically prescribed for medical, dental, or
- 9 optometric treatment purposes or to controlled substances described in this chapter.
- For the purposes of this section, "volatile chemical" includes the following chemicals or
- 11 their isomers:
- 12 a. Acetone.
- b. Aliphatic hydrocarbons.
- 14 c. Amyl nitrite.
- d. Butane.
- e. Butyl nitrite.
- f. Carbon tetrachloride.
- g. Chlorinated hydrocarbons.
- 19 h. Chlorofluorocarbons.
- i. Chloroform.
- j. Cyclohexane.
- 22 k. Diethyl ether.

25			or in a locked cabinet, where a purchaser does not have direct access before
26			sale.
27		<u>C.</u>	"Proof of age" means a document issued by a governmental agency which
28			contains a description of the individual or a photograph of the individual, or both,
29			and gives the individual's date of birth. The term includes a passport, military
30			identification card, or driver's license.
31	<u>2.</u>	A re	tailer may sell an aerosol duster that contains 1,1-difluoroethane only:
