SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4025

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying all state laws
2 to identify laws that are outdated, unnecessary, or cause undue burden on this state and its
3 citizens.

4 **WHEREAS**, the 69th Legislative Assembly recognizes the value in reviewing existing state
5 laws to determine whether the laws are outdated, unnecessary, or cause undue burden on this
6 state and its citizens; and

7 **WHEREAS**, it is a legislative responsibility to review all laws to determine whether it is
8 appropriate to repeal a law;

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
10 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

11 That the Legislative Management consider studying all state laws to identify laws that are
12 outdated, unnecessary, or cause an undue burden on this state and its citizens; and

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
14 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
15 the Seventieth Legislative Assembly.
