**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3031**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying the  
2 regulatory framework and potential economic impact of tetrahydrocannabinol infused  
3 beverages.

4 **WHEREAS**, the North Dakota Department of Agriculture regulates hemp and other varieties  
5 of cannabis sativa for agriculture and industrial purposes; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the tetrahydrocannabinol in cannabis beverages often is derived from hemp  
7 because it is legal to produce under federal law; and

8 **WHEREAS**, tetrahydrocannabinol and cannabinoid hemp beverages are emerging in the  
9 national marketplace as an alternative to alcoholic beverage with fewer after effects;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
11 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Management consider studying regulatory framework and potential  
13 economic impact of tetrahydrocannabinol infused beverages in the state; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and  
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
16 the Seventieth Legislative Assembly.
