| 11 | storing, processing, refining, and the direct sale of oil and gas products would provide the state |
| 12 | and the Legislative Assembly information necessary to determine if the model of the Bank of |
| 13 | North Dakota and the North Dakota Mill and Elevator Association would achieve the goal of |
| 14 | maximizing economic benefits to the state and its citizens; |
