HB 1119 states that legislative management shall study child care provider licensing, legislative management shall consider conducting an evaluation program of the department of health and human services child care services and create a child care services advisory committee.

4 - Fiscal Impact Sections Detail

Section 3 of HB 1119 establishes a child care services advisory committee consisting of 11 members. This committee shall conduct a comprehensive revision of administrative rules relating to child care licensing.

To complete this service, costs would be incurred for travel for the committee members and substitute pay for the

providers. The committee would meet at regular intervals throughout the biennium to complete its assigned tasks. The estimated costs (lodging, mileage, per diem, board reimbursement) would be \$105,064.00 for the 11-member group for the 25-27 Biennium.

Section 3 of HB 1119 establishes a child care services advisory committee consisting of 11 members. This committee shall conduct a comprehensive revision of administrative rules relating to child care licensing.

The total estimated costs related to HB 1119 Section 3 for the 2025-27 biennium are as follows:

The information below is based on 11 members and 12 meetings.

Lodging - 11 members x \$110/night x 12 night = \$14,520, of which is all General;

Mileage - 11 members x \$0.70/mile x 650 miles round trip per person x 12 trips = \$60,060, of which is all General;

Per Diem - 11 members x \$67 (1 breakfast, 1 lunch, 2 supper) x 12 days = \$8,844, of which is all General;

Reimbursement - 50-11.1-15 Early Childhood Services Advisory Board reimburses up to \$200 per day for expenses incurred for

hiring a substitute; 6 provider members on the child care services advisory committee; estimated 1.5 days of sub \$300 X 6 =

\$1800/meeting x 12 = \$21,600, of which is all General.

Total Expenditure (100% General Fund): \$105,064
