Representative Bosch:

This email is in response to your request for an amendment to Senate Bill No. 2014, the Industrial Commission budget. Below is a suggestion for consideration by the Conference Committee which would provide a deficiency appropriation from the general fund to the Industrial Commission to pay up to \$627,587 related to an outstanding bill from the Energy and Environmental Research Center (EERC).

SECTION \_\_. APPROPRIATION - 2023-25 BIENNIUM - INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION - HYDROGEN ENERGY RESEARCH PROJECT. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$627,587, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the industrial commission for the purpose of paying an outstanding invoice related to a hydrogen energy research project, for the period beginning with the effective date of this section and ending June 30, 2025.

SECTION \_\_. EMERGENCY. Section \_\_ of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
