Definitions


- North Dakota State Assessment (NDSA) produces a score for each student, which places the student at a performance level.
- > Student achievement is defined by four performance levels:
 - 1. Advanced: above the standard, highly proficient
 - 2. Proficient: at the grade level standard
 - 3. Partially Proficient: slightly below the standard
 - 4. Novice: below proficient, below the standard
- Met = Advanced + Proficient students
- Not Met= Partially Proficient + Novice students


- > Met = 45%
- ➤ Not Met = 54%






2023-2024 Math

- **→ Not Met = 60%**






Trend Data: 2017/18 - 2023/24 ELA (% Met)






Trend Data: 2017/18 - 2023/24 Math (% Met)
