
Chairman Nathe and members of House Appropriations – Education and Environment Division:

Where Does State Oil Tax Come from and Where Does It Go?



- 2. Workforce Retention the initiatives we deploy in partnership with the Watford City Park & Recreation District, McKenzie County JDA, McKenzie County School District #1, and through business BR&E (Business Retention & Expansion) interviews and meetings.
- 3. Workforce Development the initiatives we deploy in partnership with McKenzie County School District #1 and the Bakken Area Skills Center, and through business BR&E (Business Retention & Expansion) interviews and meetings.
- 4. Skills Development the initiatives we deploy in partnership with McKenzie County School District #1 and the Bakken Area Skills Center, and through business BR&E (Business Retention & Expansion) interviews and meetings.
- 5. Entrepreneurship Development & Expansion the initiatives we deploy in partnership with SBDC, Tri-County Development Council, Lewis & Clark Development Group, McKenzie County School District #1 and the Bakken Area Skills Center, and through business BR&E (Business Retention & Expansion) interviews and meetings.

In MANY of our workforce development initiatives we utilize in Watford City to maintain and retain the existing workforce that we need today and grow the workforce Region 1 needs by 2031 according to Job Service ND:



Employment for North Dakota Region 1 which includes the counties of McKenzie, Williams, and Divide is projected to increase from 35,641 in 2021 to 46,212 in 2031 which is a 29.7% increase. Employment for North Dakota is projected to increase from 456,703 in 2021 to 499,750 in 2031, a 9.4% increase. Region 1's projected growth rate is the highest in the state of North Dakota.
