## HB 1012 Appropriations - Human Resources Division

Mr. Chairman Nelson and Members of the Committee,

My name is Lorraine Davis, Founder and CEO of NATIVE, Inc. serving the urban Indian populations and other disproportionate populations in North Dakota since 2012. NATIVE, Inc. is a partner with the ND Behavioral Health Division as a community service provider of the Free through Recovery Program, Community Connect Program and 1915i Program serving in the Bismarck and Fargo areas. NATIVE, Inc. provides culturally responsive services and programs. I created NATIVE, Inc. to better meet the cultural needs of Native Americans living in urban areas of ND.

I am asking for \$1.9 Million dollars as an amendment to HB 1012 to include an Native American urban set aside to fiscally support culturally programming for participants and their families involved in the Free through Recovery, Community Connect and 1915i programs. \$900,000 designated toward cultural programming and \$1 M of it designated toward a community cultural center.

Due to the disproportionate representation of Native American adults in prison, Native American youth corrections and at-risk youth, and children involved in foster care and adoptions, it is critical to provide cultural and traditional healing programming amongst Native Americans living off the reservations referred to as the urban Indians within our state. Native Americans live away from their homelands, people and without cultural connections and ways of life. This is a preventive and recovery approach with access to intervention as we provide referrals to treatment centers through all the contracts/grants we have with your department.

Eligible organizations for this funding would need to be Native American behavioral health community-based service organizations serving Native populations living in two or more urban areas who are contracted with the ND Behavioral health's Community Connect, FTR,1915i and involved in the system of care program.
