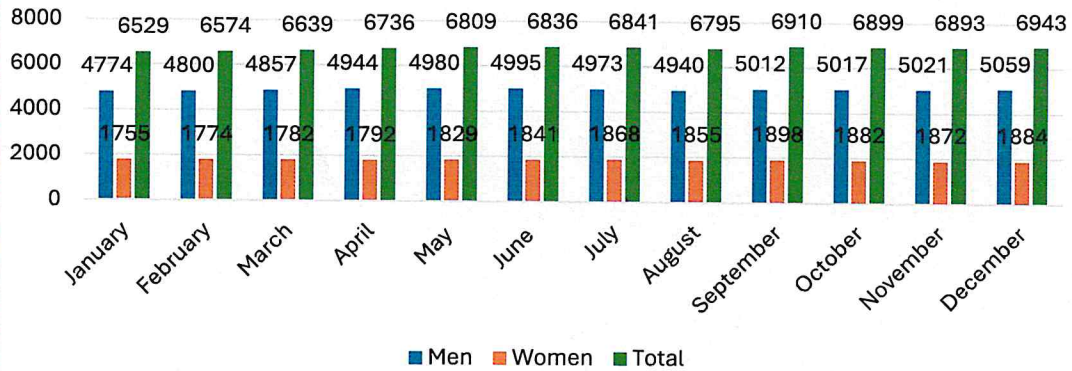

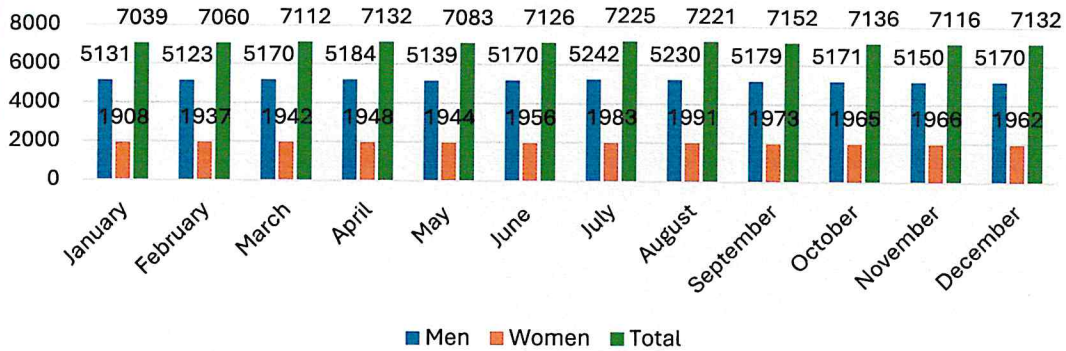
The American Parole and Probation Association recommended standards for adult community supervision caseloads are:
