REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2037 (.05000)

Page 2, lines 13 through 26:

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-04.1-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-04.1-20. Jurisdiction of court.

- 1. Unless earlier discharged by order of the court pursuant to section 12.1-04.1-22, 12.1-04.1-24, or 12.1-04.1-25, an individual found not guilty by reason of lack of criminal responsibility is subject to the jurisdiction of the court for a period equal to the maximum term of imprisonment that could have been imposed for the most serious crime of which the individual was charged but found not guilty by reason of lack of criminal responsibility. In a juvenile proceeding, a child not adjudicated by reason of lack of criminal responsibility is subject to the jurisdiction of the court for one year.
- Upon expiration of its jurisdiction under this chapter or earlier discharge by its order, the court may order that a proceeding for involuntary commitment be initiated pursuant to chapter 25-03.1. <u>In a juvenile proceeding, the court may order an investigation into whether a child in need of protection proceedings should be initiated pursuant to chapter 27-20.3.</u>

Page 22, lines 25 through 31:

SECTION 20. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES - CONTRACT SERVICES - GENERAL FUND - ONE-TIME FUNDING.

There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of health and human services for the purpose of contracting for juvenile fitness to proceed_lack of criminal responsibility evaluation services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The funding in this section is considered a one-time funding item.
