- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the council on the

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
- 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
- 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and
- 7 federal funds, to the council on the arts for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the council

15	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CULTURAL ENDOWMENT FUND. All income from the					
16	cultural endowment fund is appropriated to the council on the arts for the furthering of the					
17	cultural arts in the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.					
18	The council on the arts may use up to \$190,000\$380,000 of moneys in the cultural endowment					
19	fund for maintenance or for construction of arts across the prairie projects, for the biennium					
20	beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The council on the arts may use up to					
21	\$454,142 of moneys designated for maintenance in the cultural endowment fund for arts across					
22	the prairie site preparation and installa	ation costs.				
23	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS. All gifts, grants,					
24	devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the council on the arts are					
25	appropriated to the council on the arts for the purposes provided in section 54-54-06, for the					
26	biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and	ending June 30, 2027.				
27	SECTION 5. NEW AND VACANT	FTE POOL - LIMITATI	ON - TRANSFER R	EQUEST. The		
28	council on the arts may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE pool line item					
29	in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to transfer funds

SECTION 6. STATE TROUBADOUR - POET LAUREATE. The grants line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$15,000 for the state troubadour and \$15,000 for the poet laureate.

SECTION 7. EXEMPTION - LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - REPORT. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget shall transfer funds between line items, excluding the new and vacant FTE pool line item, in section 1 of this Act as requested by the council on the arts. The council on the arts shall notify the legislative council of any transfer made pursuant to this section. The council on the arts shall report to the budget section after June 30, 2026, any transfer made in excess of \$50,000 and to the appropriations committees of the seventieth legislative assembly regarding any transfers made pursuant to this section.

SECTION 8. EXEMPTION - UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATION. The amount of \$25,000 appropriated from the general fund for the purpose of accrued leave payouts in section 1 of chapter 10 of the 2023 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds may be continued and are available to the council on the arts for costs relating to accrued leave payouts during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.

² Funding of \$172,772 from the general fund added by the House for new FTE position salaries and wages is removed and \$155,495 is added to the new and vacant FTE pool line item resulting in a net savings of \$17,277.

³ Funding of \$150,000 from federal funds is added by the House for a temporary position for arts across the prairie.

Authorizes the Council on the Arts to use \$380,000 from moneys designated for maintenance in the cultural
endowment fund for maintenance or for construction of arts across the prairie projects. The Senate authorized
\$190,000 for maintenance or for construction of arts across the prairie projects.

Authorizes the Council on the Arts to use \$454,142 from moneys designated for maintenance in the cultural
endowment fund for arts across the prairie site preparation and installation costs. The Senate did not authorize
funding for arts across the prairie site preparation and installation costs.

Designates \$30,000 from the grants line item to provide \$15,000 each for the state troubadour and the poet laureate.

Authorizes \$25,000 of general fund carryover for accrued leave payouts. This will reduce general fund revenue available for the 2025-27 biennium by \$25,000.
