SB 2239 Amendment -

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 34-05 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Apprenticeship grant program.

- 1. The <u>labor commerce</u> commissioner shall administer an apprenticeship grant program to provide grants to eligible individuals enrolled in qualifying registered apprenticeship program within this state.
- 2. The labor commerce commissioner, in collaboration with the United States department of labor and the state board for career and technical education shall:
 - a. Establish eligibility guidelines for the program, including requiring full-time enrollment, program progress, and a minimum grade point average or its equivalent; and
 - b. Award an eligible individual up to three thousand dollars within a three-year period while enrolled in an eligible program.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND HUMAN RIGHTS

COMMERCE - APPRENTICESHIP GRANT PROGRAM. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of labor and human rightscommerce for the purpose of administering an apprenticeship grant program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.
