Good morning, Chairperson Klemin and members of the House Judiciary Committee. For the record, my name is Jason Bedsaul, Director of ODIN. My colleague, Corey Quirk, has provided the bulk of our testimony, but I'm here to expand a little on our fiscal note and stand for questions. As he mentioned and I will reiterate here – NDUS and ODIN are neutral, but we have some concerns related to Section 6 and the fiscal and logistical burdens it places on our organization.

Based on our reading of the bill and the testimony given in support of 2307 in the Senate hearing, Section 6 would require a different approach to providing access than what our current cost-effective, but admittedly, lower security solution provides. While we are confident that none of the content we support meets the federal definition of obscenity and libraries follow the Children Internet Protection Act (CIPA) that prevents access to known adult content websites, our concerns are in the broader definition of obscenity and filtering requirements being proposed by this legislation.

While a physical copy of a book can be moved to a different area of the library as is required by current state law, the digital equivalent is a bit harder to accomplish. With our current systems, the digital version of a locked cabinet would prevent access to all patrons – adults and K-12 alike.

A more robust authentication solution - such as the one provided for in our fiscal note - would create additional levels of security to allow all libraries to restrict down to the item and patron; thus, providing the tools libraries need to comply with this part of 2307.

I have attached a detailed quote, broken down by library, as well as an overview of the program that is used over a million times a month on average across the state by all types of libraries.

I would be happy to explain any of the details further and I'll stand for questions. Thank you for your time and consideration.

Statewide Database Program for North Dakota

July 2024 - June 2025

Thank you for your library's continued participation in the Statewide Database Program. The program serves the full spectrum of library users – from students in K-12 schools, to learners in academic institutions, to lifelong learners in public and special libraries with multidisciplinary database products that include full-text from journals, magazines, other periodicals, news sources, books, web content, and/or video, images, media, and content in other formats.

Resources are negotiated by Minitex (MN) with the collection selected by a task force comprised of funding partners from North Dakota, South Dakota, and Minnesota. ODIN – in collaboration with the North Dakota State Library – provides access* to participating North Dakota libraries. The current list of included resources are below and on the ODIN website: https://www.odin.nodak.edu/databases.

Billing Explanation

For FY25, The ND Statewide Database invoice totaled \$280,271. ODIN applied \$111,975 in state appropriated dollars towards the bill. The State Library contributes an additional \$9,600 to further reduce the amount billed to libraries. The remaining amount, \$158,696, is billed to participating libraries using the following formula:

- 1. Vendor usage statistics (total platform searches) were gathered based on library type and can be found at https://www.odin.nodak.edu/eresources/statistics.
- 2. Usage percentages by library type are then applied to each vendor's bill.
 - a. Example: Gale/Cengage's bill is \$50,000 after appropriated and earmarked reductions. Gale/Cengage usage percentages were 10% Academic, 85% Schools, and 5% Public Libraries. In this example, Academics would be billed \$5,000, Schools \$42,500, and Public Libraries \$2,500.
- 3. Totals for each vendor are then added together, by library type, and divided by FTE, enrollment, or population depending on type. Here is the calculated rate for **FY25**:
 - a. Academic Libraries = \$1.95 per FTE (Student and Staff combined)
 - b. Public Libraries = \$0.0134 per service population
 - c. School Libraries = \$1.58 per student enrolled in grades 9-12 last fall
 - d. Special Libraries = \$100 per library
