- A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 53-06.1-03 of the North

  Dakota Century Code, relating to a moratorium on charitable organizations purchasing alcoholic

  beverage establishments; to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 53-06.1-01 of the

  North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of alcoholic beverage establishment for purposes of conducting gaming; and to provide an expiration date.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 53-06.1-01 of the North Dakota

  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

  2. "Alcoholis beverage actablishes at the second code in the North Dakota and Table 1.1."
  - "Alcoholic beverage establishment" means an establishment licensed under <u>section</u>
     <u>5-01-21 or</u> chapter 5-02 where alcoholic beverages are sold, dispensed, and
     consumed by guests on the premises. The term does not include a liquor store, gas
     station, grocery store, or convenience store.
  - **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 53-06.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

A licensed organization, including its subsidiary, affiliate, or other related organization, may not purchase an alcoholic beverage establishment.

**SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE.** Section 2 of this Act is effective through July 31, 2027, and after that date is ineffective.
