- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
- 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
- 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying
- 9 the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
- 10 June 30, 2027, as follows:

1 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 54-07-04. Salary of governor. 4 The annual salary of the governor is one hundred fifty-two thousand two hundred sixty-five-5 dollars through June 30, 2024, and one hundred fifty-eight thousand three hundred 6 fifty-sixone hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred seven dollars through June 30, 2026. 7 and one hundred sixty-eight thousand dollars thereafter. 8 SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 9 amended and reenacted as follows: 10 54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor. 11 The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is one hundred thirty thousand dellars through-12 June 30, 2024, and one hundred thirty-five thousand two hundredone hundred thirty-nine 13 thousand two hundred fifty-six dollars through June 30, 2026, and one hundred forty-three 14 thousand four hundred thirty-four dollars thereafter. 15 SECTION 7. EXEMPTION - UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS. The sum of \$130,000 16 appropriated from the general fund for constituent management software in section 1 of 17 chapter 33 of the 2023 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 and 18 may be continued into the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.
