All funds, in addition to those appropriated in section 1 of this Act, from 4 5 federal, private, and other sources for competitive grants or other funds that the legislative 6 assembly has not indicated the intent to reject, including tuition revenue, received by the state 7 board of higher education and the institutions and entities under the control of the state board of higher education, are appropriated to the board and those institutions and entities, for the 8 9 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. All additional funds received under the North Dakota-Minnesota reciprocity agreement during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, 10 11 and ending June 30, 2027, are appropriated to the state board of higher education for 12 reimbursement to institutions under the control of the board. 13 SECTION 3. USE OF EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS FUNDING - MATCHING FUNDS. The 14 capital assets line items in subdivisions 2 through 12 of section 1 of this Act include funding from the general fund for institution extraordinary repairs. An institution, excluding the university 15 of North Dakota and North Dakota state university, shall provide one dollar of matching funds 16 from operations or other sources for each one dollar of extraordinary repairs funding used for a 17 18 project. The university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university shall provide two 19 dollars of matching funds from operations or other sources for each one dollar of extraordinary 20 repairs funding used for a project. SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 15-10-49 of the North Dakota Century 21 22 Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 23 1. Subject to legislative appropriations, each biennium during the period beginning 24 July first of each odd-numbered year and ending December thirty-first of each 25 even-numbered year, the state board of higher education shall award one dollar 26 in matching grants for every two dollars raised by the institutional foundations of: 27 Bismarck state college, Dakota college at Bottineau, Dickinson state 28 university, Lake Region state college, Mayville state university, Minot state 29 university, North Dakota state college of science, Valley City state university, 30 and Williston state college for projects dedicated exclusively to the 31 advancement of academics: and

4		(1)	Its foundation has raised at least twenty-five thousand dollars in cash or

8		(3)	The institution is not sponsoring, partnering with, applying for grants with, or
9			providing a grant subaward to any person or organization that performs, or

The board shall 7 report any transfer of funds under this section to the legislative management. 8 9 SECTION 7. EXEMPTION - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the state board of higher education may adjust 10 full-time equivalent positions as needed, subject to the availability of funds, for institutions and 11 entities under its control during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. 12 13 The North Dakota university system shall report any adjustments to the office of management and budget as part of the submission of the 2027-29 biennium budget request. 14
