## MAJOR RELATED LEGISLATION AFFECTING THE ADJUTANT GENERAL AS OF CROSSOVER

This memorandum provides information on major related legislation affecting the Adjutant General as of Crossover:

**House Bill No. 1024** - This bill provides a \$6,058,279 general fund deficiency appropriation to the Adjutant General for the 2023-25 biennium, of which \$1,763,490 is for interest repayment for outstanding Dakota Access Pipeline response loans and \$4,294,789 is to repay Bank of North Dakota loans for the state's share of disaster costs.

**House Bill No. 1073** - This bill authorizes the use of the state disaster relief fund following a declaration of a state of disaster or emergency issued by the Governor in accordance with Section 37-17.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code.

**House Bill No. 1076** - This bill increases the payment of a death benefit to the beneficiary or next of kin of a member of the National Guard who died while serving on state active duty from \$15,000 to \$100,000.

**House Bill No. 1079** - This bill renames the divisions within the Department of Emergency Services. The Division of Homeland Security would be renamed the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and State Radio would be renamed the State Emergency Communications Center.

**Senate Bill No. 2082** - This bill authorizes the Division of Homeland Security director to set fees for the state hazardous chemical fee system.

**Senate Bill No. 2114** - This bill authorizes the Division of State Radio director to set State Radio system and service fees.
