  after the third day in January of the year following the organizational session as
  provided in subsection 1 or at twelve noon on a date selected by the legislative
  management but not earlier than January second nor later than January eleventh

19	SEC	CTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. Subsection 5 of section 1 of this Act is effective through	
20	December 31, 2026, and after that date is ineffective.
