Appropriations - Government Operations Division

Chairman Wanzek, Vice Chairman Erbele, and Members of the Committee,

My name is Lorraine Davis, Founder and CEO of Native American Development Center (NADC), a Native community development financial institution (Native CDFI) designated by the U.S. Department of Treasury to serve at least 60% of Native American populations living on and off the reservation in North Dakota (ND) and 40% of all other distressed populations throughout the state, with financial services in the form of micro-business loans and consumer and credit builder loans, financial literacy, and small business development and workforce development programs.

I am requesting an amendment to SB 2018 to allocate 1,280,000 dollars toward a Native American set-aside for the 2025-2027 biennium budget, as follows:

- \$350,000 Tribal Econ Summit. This was first funded at \$350,000 during the 2023-2025 legislative session. It was a big success between the Five Tribes, State, and Federal governments.
- \$300,000 Revolving Loan Fund (pass through Bank of North Dakota). Native American Development Center would underwrite micro-business loans between \$5,000 to \$20,000 each and credit builder and consumer loans between \$1,000 to \$3,000 each.
- \$130,000 FTE Workforce Development Specialist (\$26 per hr/\$63,000 per year includes benefits) hosted at the Native American Development Center where low-income populations funnel through for housing, job seeking, and job training. NADC is partnered with Bismarck State College to host in-person and virtual (hybrid) college and career readiness programs for Native American high school and adults and other low-income populations in the Bismarck area. This platform will NADC/BSC to serve statewide through its hybrid format.
- \$500,000 (One-time funding) Small Business Incubator in Bismarck, ND.
 NADC conducted a feasibility in 2022; the results revealed a need for a small business incubator for Native and other distressed populations in ND.

Recommendations for Eligibility:

Must have been a Native Community Development Financial Institute (Native CDFI) for at least five years serving populations across North Dakota.
