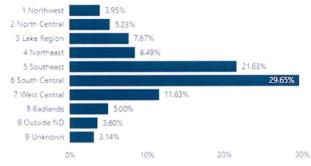




### **Admissions by Human Service Center Region**

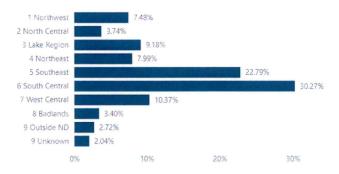

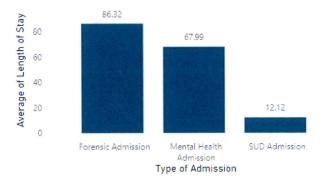

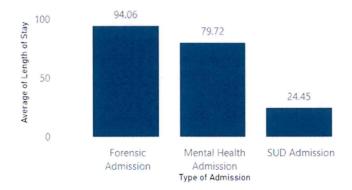
# **Average Length of Stay by Admission Type**

## **Admissions by Civil Order Type**

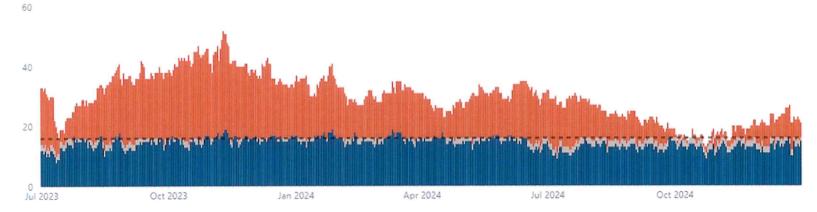


### Pending Admissions vs. Admissions L100 (APSA) Occupancy

#### Average Daily Active Patient Count - APSA

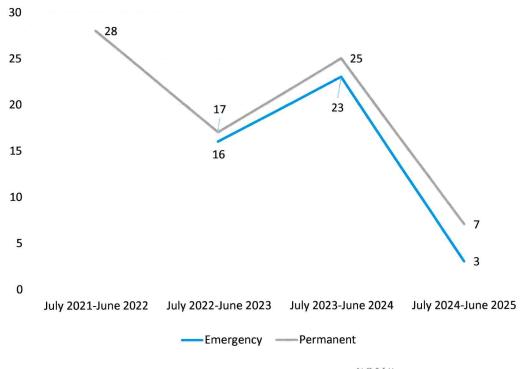

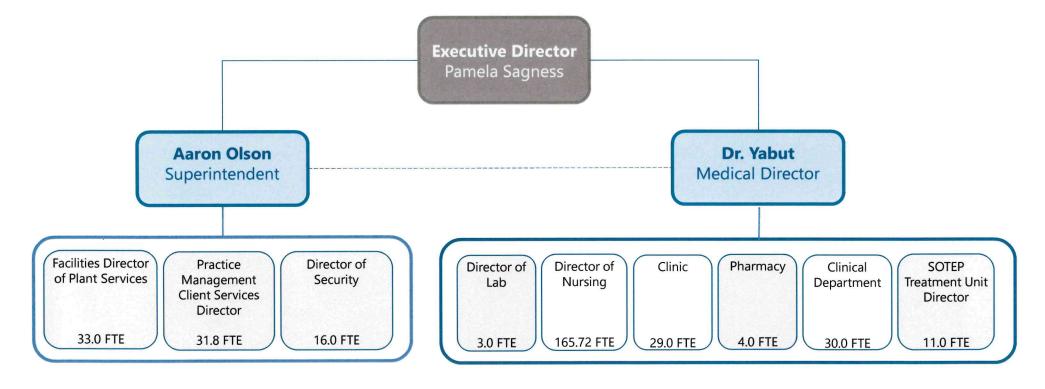

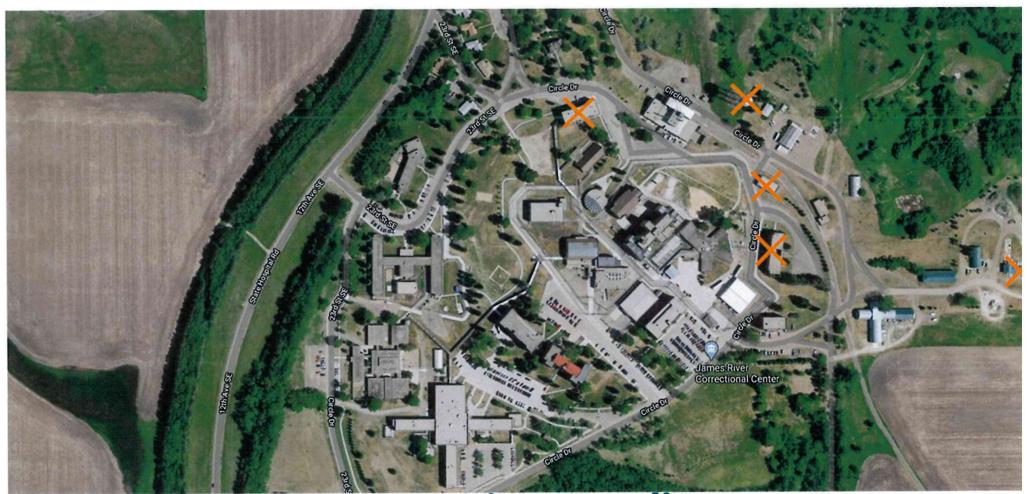
