# Overview of Impacted Grants



North Dakota HHS received \$97.38 million in CARES Act and other funding for three Epidemiology/Lab Capacity grants. About \$57 million had not yet been expended and was obligated through May 31, 2026. The funding had been reserved for technology updates and responding to possible future disease control and prevention needs.



HHS was also awarded a \$31.2 million Health Disparities grant from CARES, ARPA and other funding to support health strategies, system improvement and public education; \$3.4 million remained and was obligated through May 31, 2026.



In addition, HHS received three federal pandemic-era grants totaling about \$32 million from ARPA, CARES and other sources to support Immunization efforts. \$8.4 million remained, which was obligated in contracts to local public health units and other providers and for public education through June 30, 2025.
