- 1 higher education, are appropriated to the board and those institutions and entities, for the
- 2 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. All additional funds received under
- 3 the North Dakota-Minnesota reciprocity agreement during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025,
- 4 and ending June 30, 2027, are appropriated to the state board of higher education for
- 5 reimbursement to institutions under the control of the board.

SECTION 4. USE OF EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS FUNDING - MATCHING FUNDS. The capital assets line items in subdivisions 2 through 12 of section 1 of this Act include funding from the general fund for institution extraordinary repairs. An institution, excluding the university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university, shall provide one dollar of matching funds from operations or other sources for each one dollar of extraordinary repairs funding used for a project. The university of North Dakota and North Dakota state university shall provide two dollars of matching funds from operations or other sources for each one dollar of extraordinary repairs funding used for a project.

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS

FUND - NORTH DAKOTA UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OFFICE - EDUCATION CHALLENGE

- **FUND.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the strategic investment and improvements
- 17 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,500,000, or so much of the
- 18 sum as may be necessary, to the North Dakota university system office for the purpose of
- 19 providing higher education challenge grants, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

Senate Bill No. 2003 - Summary of Senate Action

This amendment appropriates an additional \$1.5 million from the strategic investment and improvements fund to the North Dakota University System office to provide a total of \$26.5 million for higher education challenge grants. This amendment also expands eligibility for challenge grants to the University of Jamestown and the University of Mary, each of which may be awarded up to \$750,000 during the 2025-27 biennium.
