

 - i. Funding derived from: General Funds
 - ii. Award criteria:
 - Talent attraction marketing and locally implemented strategies for business, industry, and communities that leverages existing statewide assets like Find the Good Life platform and pipeline to recruit employees nationwide and retain students and recent graduates. - cap of \$250,000
 - 2. Retention cap of \$250,000.00.
 - 3. Infrastructure investments that directly relate to the proposed workforce solution cap of \$500,000.
 - 4. Infrastructure investments that expand a childcare center cap of \$500,000. The childcare must be a center and cannot be homebased or in a site that can be repurposed for housing.


